As stated in NePA's Standing Rules, to be eligible to run for office, a person must:

1. Be an active member in good standing with dues paid at the date of the Annual Membership Meeting;
2. Have been a member of NePA for at least 1 year prior to serving as an officer;
3. Have consented to run;
4. Have not served more than 2 consecutive full years in that office; and
5. Not hold more than 1 elective office at 1 time (except the President may or may not also serve as NALA Liaison Officer, and any officer may also be a District Director at the same time).

NOTE: To be eligible to run as a Director, a person must be a voting (active - not student or associate) member located within the district he or she represents. To be eligible to run as NALA Liaison Officer, you must be an individual member of the National Association of Legal Assistants.

If you are interested in candidacy for any office, you are urged to read the Bylaws pertaining to the duties of that office (Article XII). A brief summary of the duties of each officer is enclosed. Enclosed is a Declaration of Candidacy form for any member wishing to declare (consent to) candidacy. Please complete the form and return it by mail or e-mail to the Nominations & Election Committee's attention.

Also enclosed for your use is a Nominating Ballot to nominate someone for an office. Please complete the form and return it by mail or e-mail to the Nominations & Election Committee's attention.

All forms should be returned to the Nominations & Election Committee by July 30, 2010.
Nominations will also be accepted from the floor.

Election by ballot will be held during the Annual Membership Meeting. If a quorum is not present, a mail vote will be taken immediately following the Membership Meeting.
